WINE NOTES

Johannisberger Klaus 1961 Riesling Cabinet

Orig. Abfullung J. Klein - Erben

This is considered to be one of the better wines of the world famous Johannisberger group of vineyards located in the Reingau. 1961 was not a great year for German wines except in quantity, but this one is pleasant to taste, mildly fragrant, and delicate.

Hattenheimer Mannberg 1961 Riesling Cabinet

Orig. Abfullung L. Von Simmernsche-Eltville

Hattenheim's best vineyards adjoin those of the more famous Erbach-virtually being prolongations of the Marcobrunn. The one very important exception is that of Steinberg-one of Germany's greatest vineyards. Good Hattenheimers have considerable texture, finesse and charm.

Erdener Treppchen 1959 Feine Spaetlese

Orig. Abfullung A. Ahrens - Ehlen

An Erdener of a great year like 1959 is quite superb. This fine wine from the Moselle region is characterized by floweriness of bouquet, a cleanness on the palate, and refreshing lightness. The best of Erden's vineyards is called Treppchen or "little stairway" derived from the steepness of the hillside plantings.

Assmannshauser 1961

H. Berndes - Ingelheim

All of Germany's finest wines are white, but there are some red wines produced. The most famous comes from Assmannshausen, just north of Rudesheim in the Rheingau. This wine is made from the Pinot Noir, or Spaetburgunder grape but is not to be compared with good French burgundy. It would stand up only to an average California red.

Hallgartener Schoenhell 1959 Spaetlese Cabinet

Orig. Abfullung Fass #69 Vereinigte Weinguts Besitzer

Hallgarten is one of the upland villages as distinguished from the river towns of the Rheingau. In great years it produces wines of extraordinary quality characterized by tremendous fullness in body similar to the Rudesheimers, but drier and generally with less alcohol. Schoenhell is considered the best vineyard of Hallgarten.

Rauenthaler Baiken 1959 Trockenbeerenauslese

Orig. Abfullung Schloss Eltz Graflich Eltzische-Eltville

Rauenthal is a modest village back in the Taunus hills, 2 miles north of Eltville in the Rheingau. Its wines bring consistently high prices at the German auctions, and they are characterized by ripeness and a somewhat spicy flavor. Rauenthaler Baiken is now classed for tax purposes as the most valuable agricultural land in Germany. This, according to the experts would probably qualify it as Germany's best vineyard.

Kummel Gilka

Most of the flavor of Kummel comes from caraway seeds. German varieties such as Gilka, made in Hamburg, are generally less sweet than the French. An interesting variant, Allasch Kummel, is flavored with bitter almonds and other herbs.

Asbach Uralt

This 80 proof grape brandy is made in Rudesheim and is said to be the best that West Germany offers.

Dr. Louis Skinner, president of the society, says, "We don't have the dinners too often, we serve small portions and avoid the heavy, caloric foods."

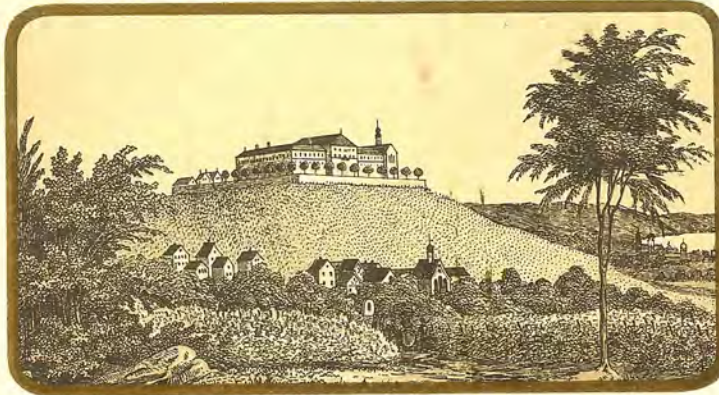
No cocktails are served, only wines with each course.
