## WINE NOTES

### Champagne Brut Taittinger

Champagne owes its special qualities to the Pinot grape and to the peculiar limestone soil of the vineyards which lie just east of Paris around Reims and Epernay. Most champagne is made from black grapes but the fine "blanc de blancs", are made exclusively from white ones. Sugar syrup is added to all champagne and there is confusion as to the degree of sweetness designated on the labels. Brut is the driest of all containing less than 1.5% of sugar by volume. Sec contains about 4% and demi sec up to 8%. Brut is the pride of the champagne firms because there is very little sugar to hide any defects. Old roués like it for seduction because it makes a girl thirsty and eager for more.

### Amontillado Sandeman

Sherry, the greatest wine of Spain, is made primarily from the white Palomino grape in Andalusia near the city of Jerez. It is fortified by the addition of brandy and, like Port and Champagne, it is a blend of wines. Addition of a very sweet wine made from the Pedro Ximenez grape enables sherry to run from very dry "fino" to very sweet "oloroso". Amontillado has a rather nutty taste and being on the less sweet side would be classified as a medium dry fino.

### Pouilly-Fuissé 1962 Joseph Drouhin

Pouilly-Fuissé is produced in the district of Maconnais near Beaujolais. The vineyards lie between the villages of Pouilly and Fuissé from which the name derives. Close by are the lesser known communes of Vinzelles and Loché which also add the surname, Pouilly, to their wines. The Pinot Chardonnay is planted and the wines have a greenish-tinted golden color. Fairly full bodied, Pouilly-Fuissé has a special soft dryness and its own original bouquet.

### Nuits-St. Georges Les Cailles 1959 P. Misserey

Nuits-St. Georges is the Southern most town of the Cote de Nuits. Originally it was simply called Nuits but later added the name of the adjacent vineyard of St. Georges. Among the vineyards of the Nuits St. Georges area is Les Cailles covering only ten acres. Classified as a Tete de Cuvee, this wine is noted for more body and staying power than those of the Cote de Beaune. In general, the wines of Nuits St. Georges resemble those of Vosne being velvety when matured.

### Clos Vougeot 1959 P. Misserey

Deriving its name from the river Vouge the vineyards of Vougeot consist of 125 acres. Since there are some 50 proprietors in the area, it is natural that it should show a great deal of variation in quality. However, all of the Vougeot wine is full bodied, perfumed and finely balanced. The name "clos" designates the wall built around the original vineyard.

### Ch. de Malle 1957 Sauternes

Coming from the commune of Preignac adjacent to Sauternes is Chateau de Malle. This is listed as a second classified growth and is owned by the Lur Saluces family better known for their great Chateau Yquem. Chateau de Malle is considered to be a good wine moderately rich in sugar and delicate in bouquet and taste. Like other Bordeaux dessert wines of the Sauternes group, Chateau de Malle is deceptively strong averaging close to 14% in alcohol.


