WINE NOTES

Chablis Premier Cru 1962 Joseph Drouhin

This wine is not particularly characteristic of its usual type in that it lacks the dry steely or flinty quality usually associated with the classic Chablis. It is softer, even a little flowery and is presented as an unusual example of the 1962 vintage from this somewhat isolated wine area in Northern Burgundy.

Beaune Clos des Mouches Blanc 1959 Joseph Drouhin

Clos des Mouches produces mostly red wine but Joseph Drouhin makes this interesting and not too well known white one from the Pinot Chardonnay grape in that part of the vineyard near the boundary of Pommard. Though a little harder, it has the bouquet, elegance and body reminiscent of the better known Meursault.

Pernand-Vergelesses-Clos de la Croix de Pierre 1959 L. Jadot

Pernand is in the northernmost part of the Cote de Beaune and this wine is from the vineyard of Iles des Vergelesses considered to be the best of that area. It is similar in character to the red Cortons, and like most Beaune reds, is softer, lighter and less well defined than the wines of the Cote de Nuits.

Nuits St. Georges-Clos de la Marechale 1959 J. Faiveley

Actually coming from Premeaux in the southern part of the Cote de Nuits this wine is so similar to Nuits St. Georges that the Appellation laws allow use of its more famous name. The wines of the Cote de Nuits are generally noted for firmness, dark color, heavy tannin, and full body. Clos de la Marechale covers twenty five acres, making it the largest single vineyard in Burgundy belonging to one owner.

Chateau Coutet Premier Grand Cru Barsac 1958

Adjacent to Sauternes, the commune of Barsac boasts two great white dessert wines. Our Chateau Coutet is a little drier and lighter than Chateau Climens which is just down the road and is more like the heavy, luscious Yquem. Coutet has its own special character, however, and is more popular than Climens. Grape variety here is two thirds Semillon and one third Sauvignon and Muscadelle.

Armagnac Marquis d'Avignon

From the Gascon country of d'Artagnan in the Department of Gers comes Armagnac, a brandy as distinctive as the people who make it. The best comes from Bas-Armagnac where the country is less hilly. It is aged in black oak barrels and usually marketed in a round, flat bottle. Armagnac is not as sharp or dry as Cognac but is more full-bodied, somewhat darker in color, and generally softer on the tongue.
