OPPENHEIMER KROTENBRUNNEN 1962

Named after a small town (Oppenheim) on the Rhein in Rheinhessen. The wine is soft and fruity. Krottenbrunnen is perhaps one of the superior vineyards.

POUILLY-FUISSE 1966

All Pouillys are made exclusively from the Pinot Chardonnay Grape and are among the finest White Burgundys. The wine is dry and very clean on the palate in the superb bouquet and flavour.

CHATEAU MARGAUX (FIRST GROWTH) 1960

One of the top ranking wines of the Medoc and one of the world's greatest clarets.

P. Biarnes, the uncrowned poet laureate of Bordeaux commands us to bow before the fine chateau :

*"Inclinez votre front, flechissez les genoux
Amis, Chateau Margaux s'eleve devant nous !
Viola l'un des trois rois, l'un des trois dieux du monde."*

BARSAC 1962

One of the best known communes of the wine district of Sauterne. All Borsacs are legally Sauternes. It is generally lighter and a shade less sweet with a special fruitiness bouquet.
