Mother's Day Brunch Upcoming Events

In a rare circumstance, I missed a Council Bluffs event. I was in France attending two IWFS Festivals: Alsace and Paris / Bordeaux. I can't readily recall a previous Council Bluffs event that started before noon. But I am usually the photographer as well as the event reporter. We had substitutes for this month's gazette. Mike Wilde took the photos...all of 5 of them. It must have gotten really busy, or the wine was really good! LOL. Joe Goldstein wrote our report.

Since we seem to have a photo famine, I will supplement with shots from the IWFS Alsace Festival. We went to what many would consider a First Growth of Alsace, even though Alsace does not have a classification system like the Bordeaux Medoc. Domaine Weinbach / Faller is one of Alsace's best wineries. The building started out in 1612 as a Capuchin monastery. In the 19th century, the Faller family began making wine. They are right below the Schlossberg Grand Cru vineyard, so you see labels referring to the Cuvée des Capuchins and the Grand Cru Schlossberg. Alsace has 51 grand cru vineyard sites on the slopes of the Voges Mountain foothills. We had a nice tasting of Weinbach's wines, some in magnum. All are extraordinary expressions of their terroir. I see you had two Alsatian sparkling wines, called Crémant, at the Pasta Amore brunch. Those are usually pretty good as well.

We mourn the loss of one of our founders, John Fischer, who died on June 25, 2022 from complications of Parkinson's Disease. John was a great guy and loved wine and food pairings. He will be missed.


