

Lunch at the Ambassador

Saturday 9th October



Exmouth Market has more than its fair share of critically-acclaimed restaurants, with the Ambassador Café among them. Recommended by the Good Food Guide the restaurant is decked out with white globe lights and Formica tables and at first glance looks unremarkable. All the detail has cleverly gone into the terrific modern and eclectic European menu.

There is a smart wine list, with intriguing choices by the glass and the half litre. The Ambassador owes its success to owner Clive Greenhalgh whose background at the front of house at The Brackenbury (now closed) and Bank Restaurant (St. James) have held him in good stead.



The lunch will commence with a glass of **Prosecco** followed by a **three course menu with matching wines**. On the day there will be 2 choices of starters, mains and deserts, which at the time of printing are:

Crab Bisque Or Game Terrine with Cornichons & Poilaine Toast

Barbary Duck Breast with Sarladaise Potatoes & Savoy cabbage

(Wine: Umbria, Assisi Sangiovese, Sportoletti 07)

Or

Monkfish & Gurnard Bourride

(Wine: Tuscany, Toscana Bianco, Poggiotondo 09)

Panacotta with Blackberries Or Chocolate Tart

(Wine: Monbazillac, Chateau Septy 05)
