For those who are keen for a taste of the South Island, a post-tour has also been arranged to the world's southern-most wine region, Queenstown (Central Otago). Best known for its pinot noir, it also boasts beautiful mountains and glistening rivers.

AUCKLAND MAIN FESTIVAL

IWFS Auckland branch, led by Rowan Moss, will host this entire festival. We would like to thank Rowan and his committee for the huge effort in putting this brilliant programme together.

Friday 8th March 2019

OPENING DINNER AT SAILS RESTAURANT, WESTHAVEN

Our opening dinner will be held at *Sails Restaurant*, an iconic restaurant overlooking Westhaven Marina. The restaurant has gained a reputation as one of the top restaurants in New Zealand using the freshest produce from the land and the sea. We will also be treated to a Maori welcome performed by the *Auckland Museum Maori Entertainment Group*.



Saturday 9th March 2019

AUCKLAND CITY TOUR

We will begin our day with a coach city tour of Auckland.

LUNCH AT GIRAFFE, VIADUCT HARBOUR

After our tour, we'll be lunching at *Giraffe*, Simon Gault's restaurant where he presents an eclectic variety of dishes using both traditional and molecular techniques. Following lunch, for those not involved in the Presidents' Round Table, there will be an opportunity to either take a cruise under sail on the harbour on board the sailing scow *Ted Ashby* for one hour or visit the *Sky Summit Tower*.



GALA DINNER, STAMFORD PLAZA HOTEL

After a lovely and relaxing afternoon, our traditional black-tie dinner will be held at the hotel. Members are invited to wear their medallions to this event.



Sunday 10th March 2019

AGM, STAMFORD PLAZA HOTEL (10.15am)

First order of the day will be our APZ Annual General Meeting. All Asia Pacific members are encouraged to attend.

2019 ANDRÉ SIMON LECTURE (11am), BUFFET LUNCH (12noon)

After the APZ AGM at 10.15am, the 2019 André Simon lecture will be presented by Bob Campbell MW on 'The development of the NZ wine industry from 1954 up until today'. Bob Campbell MW, one of New Zealand's most respected wine commentators and judges, is a very entertaining speaker who knows the New Zealand wine industry inside out. A buffet style lunch will be served immediately after the lecture.

CLOSING DINNER AT TANTALUS ESTATE, WAIHEKE ISLAND

After our free afternoon, we will meet to take the 35 minute ferry ride across the harbour to beautiful Waiheke Island for a tasting and dinner. Waiheke Island was rated by *Lonely Planet Guide* as the fifth best destination in the world and a must to visit in your lifetime. Although our visit will be only brief, it will give members the chance to experience exactly what it is that has put Waiheke on the map – the production of exceptional wines, of which *Tantalus* is the new kid on the block, but don't let that fool you – their wines are extremely good for a young producer. You should not miss this. We will return to Auckland by ferry after the dinner, arriving Auckland about 10.30pm.



PROGRAMME MONDAY 4TH - THURSDAY 7TH MARCH, 2019

NAPIER, HAWKE'S BAY PRE-TOUR

For those who can escape that little bit earlier, Napier, in the sunny wine region of Hawke's Bay located on the east coast of the North Island, will play host as a beautiful introduction to this gorgeous country.

DAY 1 Monday 4th March 2019

NAPIER TOUR & CRAGGY RANGE VINEYARD

We will depart from Auckland on a specially arranged charter flight arriving in beautiful Napier around midday. So you should aim to arrive Auckland by the evening of Sunday March 3 so that you can join the charter flight on Monday morning to Napier.

From the airport we will head into the gorgeous art-deco city of Napier for a tour with Clarence Bertram Saint John Fitz Montague – Bertie to his friends. At 3.30pm we will check into the *Crown Hotel*, freshen up and relax before heading to *Craggy Range*, an iconic family vineyard below the magnificent Te Mata Peak. Here we will enjoy a tour of the vineyard followed by dinner at their restaurant, *Terroir*.



DAY 2 Tuesday 5th March 2019

BROOKFIELDS, BLACK BARN, TE MATA & MISSION ESTATE

First, we will head to Hawke's Bay's oldest boutique winery, *Brookfields* which was founded in 1937, for a tasting.

From Brookfields we will head to the lovely *Black Barn Vineyard* for lunch at about 12.30pm, which will be followed by a tasting with wine maker, Dave McKee.

Departing at 2pm, we will make a stop at *Te Mata Estate* for a *Coleraine* and *Bullnose* tasting with Toby Buck, before arriving back in Napier at 4pm and a chance to relax.

For dinner, you're in for a treat, as we head to New Zealand's oldest winery and birthplace of New Zealand wine, *Mission Estate*.



DAY 3 Wednesday 6th March 2019

TRINITY HILL, TE AWA, ASHRIDGE & CHURCH ROAD

First we will stop at *Trinity Hill* for a tasting of *Homage* and *Gimblett*, before heading to *Te Awa* for a *Kidnapper Cliffs* tasting and lunch. Around 2pm we will arrive at *Ashridge Wines* to meet Chris Wilcock for a tasting of *Dopio* and reserve *Syrah*s. After some free time in the afternoon, we will enjoy our pre-tour closing dinner at *Church Road*. After dinner, we will overnight in Napier and return by charter flight to Auckland the next morning



DAY 4 Thursday 7th March 2019

RETURN CHARTER FLIGHT NAPIER TO AUCKLAND, FREE TIME IN AUCKLAND

A good opportunity to have a free afternoon to explore Auckland at your own speed before the commencement of the main festival in Auckland on Friday 8th March.



PROGRAMME MONDAY 11TH - THURSDAY 14TH MARCH, 2019

QUEENSTOWN, CENTRAL OTAGO POST-TOUR

For those who have a little more time after the Auckland Festival, we will travel to New Zealand's South Island to visit the beautiful town of Queenstown and the highly renowned Central Otago wine region.

DAY 1 Monday 11th March 2019

ARRIVE QUEENSTOWN, DINNER AT ROSIE B'S (7PM)

Today we wake up in Auckland and proceed to Queenstown. After settling in to the hotel, we will head out for a special dinner presented by Peter Gauron, Executive Chef of *Rosie B's*. For those booking this post-tour we will contact you later to advise details and cost of a charter flight so that we can fly together if you wish from Auckland to Queenstown on Monday 11th, arriving *Hilton Hotel* late afternoon. We will be using *Air New Zealand*. Otherwise, feel free to book your own flight making sure to arrive at the Hilton in Queenstown in time to travel to the restaurant at 6.30pm for dinner at 7pm.

DAY 2 Tuesday 12th March 2019

GIBSTON VALLEY

Today we head to *Chard Farm* for a gorgeous pre-lunch tasting of great CO aromatics and fantastic Pinot Noirs. We will then head to the two hatted *Amisfield* for lunch, located at beautiful Lake Hayes.

Following lunch, we will head to *Valli Wines* and meet one of New Zealand's most awarded Pinot Noir winemakers, Grant Taylor. Grant also produces great Riesling and Pinot Noir from the little known region of Waitaki. Next we head to *Peregrine Wines*, whose focus is on growing premium Pinot Noir and white varieties from their estate managed vineyards, which are meticulously hand-tended and farmed under a sustainable philosophy.

After some relaxing and a freshen up, we will head into town via water taxi and enjoy a Winemakers Dinner at the *Botswana Butchery*.

DAY 3 Wednesday 13th March 2019

FREE TIME IN QUEENSTOWN, DINNER AT THE BUNKER

Queenstown is a town with so very much to do. We will give you a long list of wonderful recommendations to make the most of your free day. A fabulous dinner will be held at the gourmet restaurant *The Bunker*, one of Queenstown's best kept secrets. You are in for a major treat.

DAY 4 Thursday 14th March 2019

BANNOCKBURN TO CLYDE, CLOSING DINNER AT WALTER PEAK

Today we take a drive down to Clyde and visit *Two Paddocks*, which is a family vineyard that specialises in premium quality Pinot Noir. Lunch will follow at an organic vineyard and winery located in Bannockburn. After lunch we will visit the world acclaimed *Felton Road* vineyard and winery nestled amongst a spectacular scenery of snow-capped mountains.

There will be time to freshen up before we head out for our closing dinner. We will take a short cruise on the historic *TSS Earnslaw* across Lake Wakatipu to *Walter Peak High Country Farm*. Here we will enjoy a gourmet BBQ dinner on the lakeside terrace of the *Homestead Restaurant*, and also see a farm demonstration.

Friday 15th March 2019

It is up to you to organise your own outbound flight from Queenstown. Queenstown is an international airport so you may choose not to return to Auckland – however, destinations from Queenstown are limited so please check first.

Please note that if you wish to stay extra nights at the Stamford Plaza, the hotel is prepared to extend the discount rate to any night from 3rd March 2018 through 14th March 2018 inclusive, just give them the dates you wish to stay.

NAPIER PRE-TOUR

The cost of your hotel at the *Crown Hotel* is included in the Pre-Tour package fee. It covers three nights - the evenings of Monday March 4, Tuesday March 5 and Wednesday March 6. We will book your room on your behalf.

QUEENSTOWN POST-TOUR

The cost of your hotel at the *Hilton Hotel* in Queenstown is included in the Post-Tour package fee. It covers four nights - the evenings of Monday March 11, Tuesday March 12, Wednesday March 13 and Thursday March 14. We will book your room on your behalf. If you wish to stay extra nights after the conclusion of the Post-Tour, you will need to let us know.

In Napier, the cost of three nights, March 4, March 5 and March 6 are included in your package fee. In Queenstown, the nights of March 11, March 12, March 13 and March 14 are included in your package fee.

CANCELLATION FEES

Cancellations prior to December 1 will be subject to a non-refundable amount of AUD\$400 per person for each one of the modules booked (Napier Pre-Tour, Auckland Main Festival, Queenstown Post-Tour). Cancellations between December 1 and January 3 will be subject to a 40% cancellation fee. Cancellations between January 4 and February 3 will be subject to a 50% cancellation fee. Cancellations after February 3 are non-refundable. We strongly suggest you take out a travel insurance policy to protect yourself from any loss resulting from unforeseen cancellation (e.g. due to illness) of your attendance at the festival.

CLOSING NOTE AND VISAS

We are looking forward to seeing you in March in Auckland and perhaps Napier and/or Queenstown. Please check if you will need a visa to enter New Zealand. If so, you will need to arrange for this as soon as possible.
