# **MESSAGE FROM THE CHAIR**

After the festive activities it is nice to be at home for a while before the programme of IWFS meetings and events kicks in. We are fortunate to have a local Michelin starred restaurant *Northcote*, (with Lisa Goodwin-Allen their Executive Chef) who organise '*Obsession*', eighteen consecutive nights where visiting international chefs cook for one evening.

We only managed to attend a few evenings, as it is highly popular, but have in past years enjoyed the cooking of Lanshu Chen, Le Mout, Taichung City Taiwan, and Peter Templehoff, The Greenhouse, Constantia South Africa, and this year The Berezutskiy Twins, from Moscow Russia. Their restaurant The Twins Garden is one of only two Russian restaurants listed in the top 51-100 restaurants of the world. With impeccable credentials, (Sergey trained at Alinea in Chicago, and Ivan at El Bulli and El Cellar de Can Roca in Spain) they produced an 8-course meal which included typical Russian ingredients such as Sea urchin caviar, Adjika crab, and Sturgeon, a thoroughly enjoyable meal.

It was nice not to have to travel to Moscow to sample their fare, and I hope you have a local restaurant who occasionally feature a visiting chef or winemaker. Having said that we are still hopeful that our Moscow Branch Chairman, Leonid Gelibtermann, will put together a festival in Russia and Moscow.
