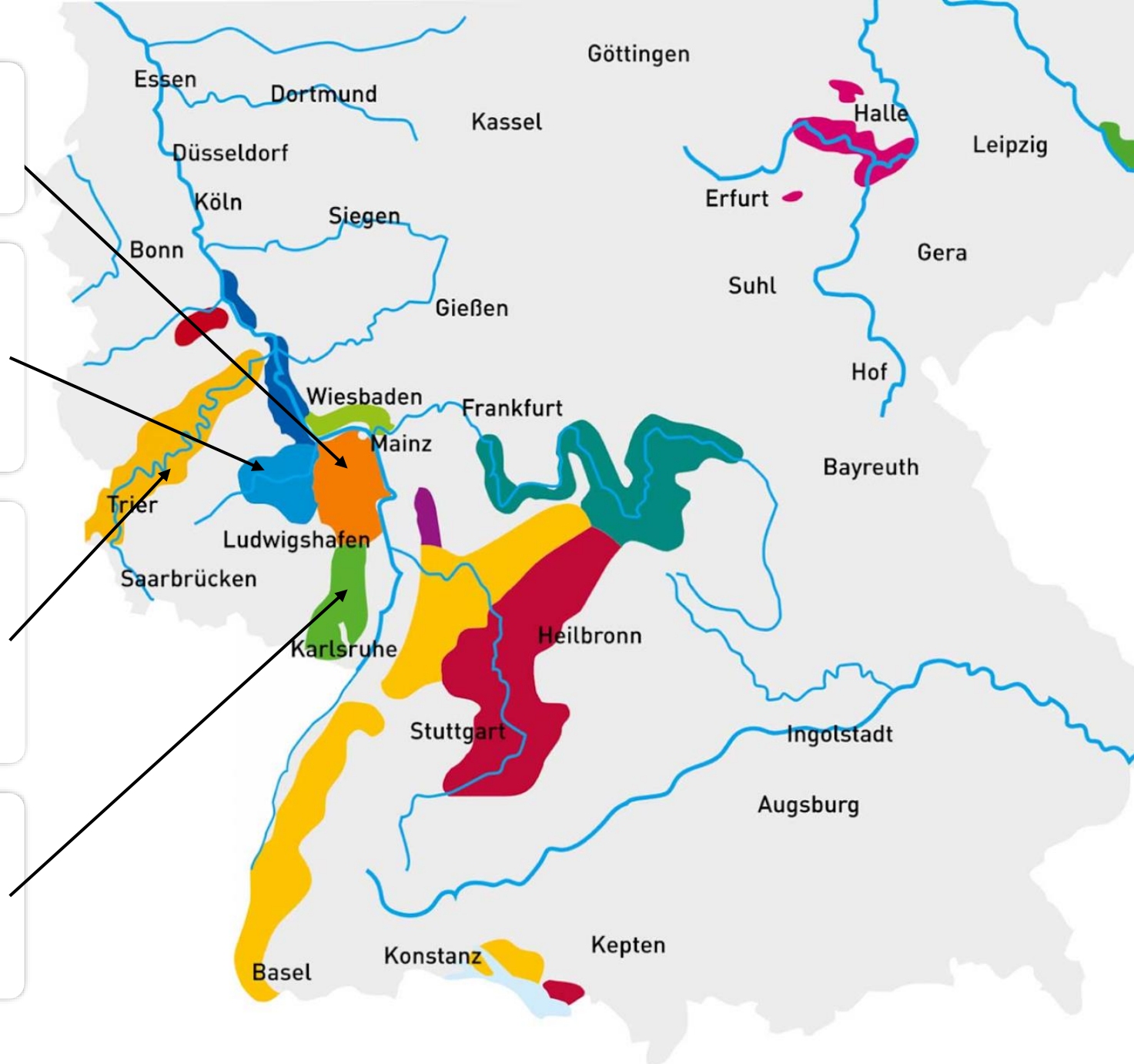

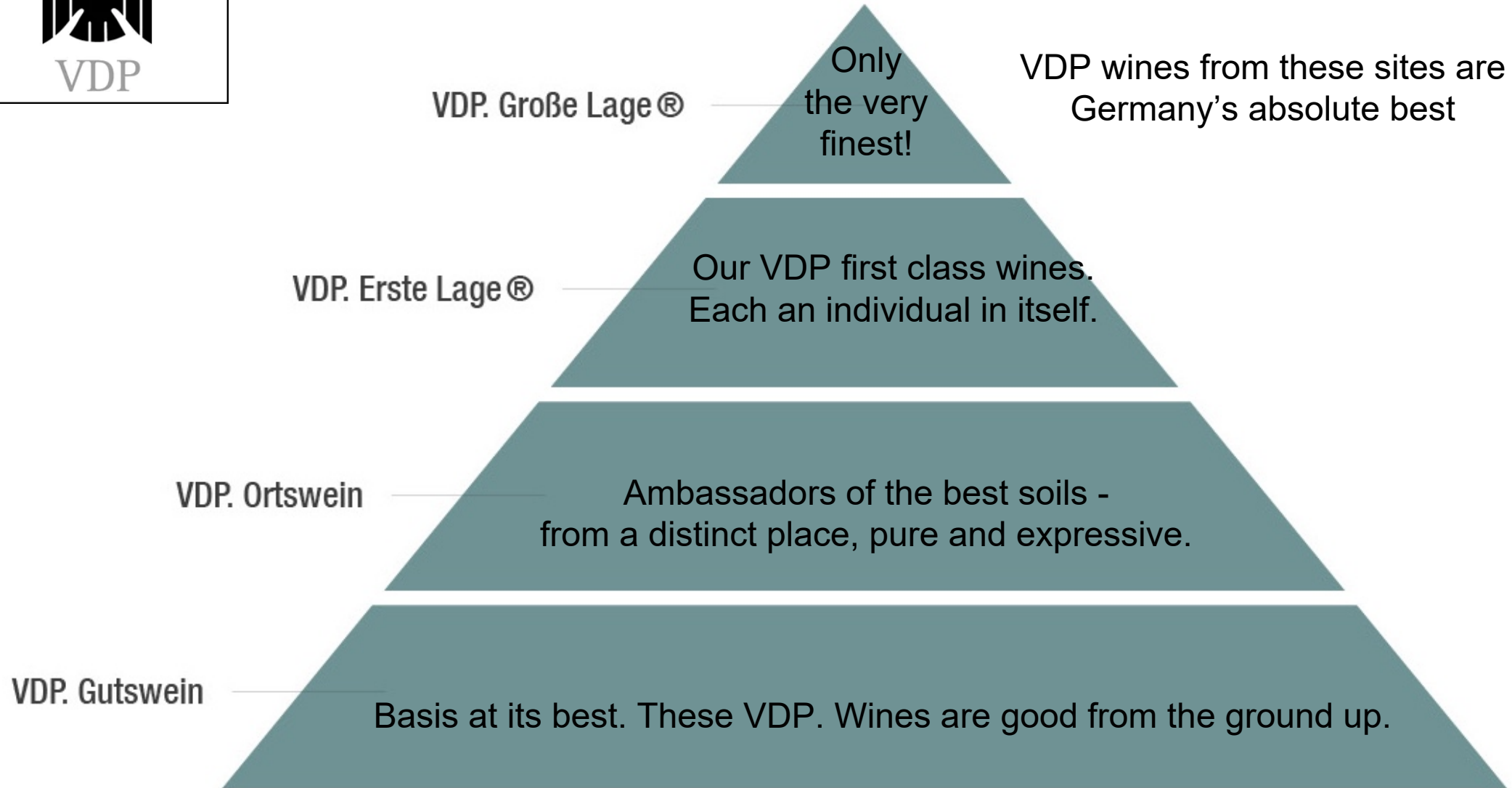

RHEINHESSEN

- Germany's largest winegrowing region with over 26,000 hectares of vineyards.
- Mild, sunny climate with low rainfall and gentle rolling hills contrasted with steep slopes near the Rhine.
- While much of the region is composed of loess, loam and limestone, the most famous sites are known for their Rotliegenden soil
- Known for **Riesling**, **Silvaner**, and **Pinot varieties**
- Exciting dry wines are gaining international acclaim.
- Focus on sustainability and terroir-driven wines.

Key Producers

- Wittmann, Keller, and Wagner-Stempel are among the region's stars.





SEKTHAUS RAUMLAND

Founded in 1984

- Volker Raumland is often regarded as the pioneer for quality Sekt in Germany
- Biodynamic Farming
- Chalky Limestone Soils very similar to Champagne
- A focus on traditional Champagne varieties
- Hand Harvesting
- Méthode Champenoise
- Minimum 36 months on the lees on everything

- NAHE**
- Nestled between the Mosel and Rheinhessen
 - About 4,000 hectares under vine, making it one of Germany's smallest.
 - A microclimate created by the Nahe River, offering a mix of cooler and warmer conditions.
 - Steep slopes, and riverbanks with a blend of granite, slate, sandstone, and volcanic soils.



WHAT IS GROSSES GEWÄCHS?

- Great Growth
- Established in 2002
- Grosse Lage (Grand Cru) vineyard
- Single varietal
- Low yields (not to exceed 50HL/hectare)
- Spätlese ripeness minimum
- Hand Harvested Fruit
- Fermented dry (less than 9g/l of RS)
- Approved by tasting panel





Bockenauer Felseneck

- Despite the deep roots the Fröhlich family has in the region, the true turning point for the winery happened in 1995 with Tim Fröhlich's first vintage. He was only 21.
- Tim's philosophy is centered around transparency, energy and elegance.
- 6 different Grand Cru sites
- Everything is farmed organically exclusively from their estate vineyards

PFALZ

- Located between the Haardt Mtn Range and the Rhein River
- Pfalz has the 2nd largest number of vines in Germany
- Predominantly limestone soils
- Plantings have tripled since the 1990s
- Relatively warm dry climate; Rainshadow caused by Haardt Mountains
- Wide range of soil types

- Founded in 2000
- Estate is run by three siblings. Andy, Steffan and Simone Rings
- Everything is farmed biodynamically, with the main focus being on regenerative farming practices
- Accepted into the VDP faster than any other winery in history

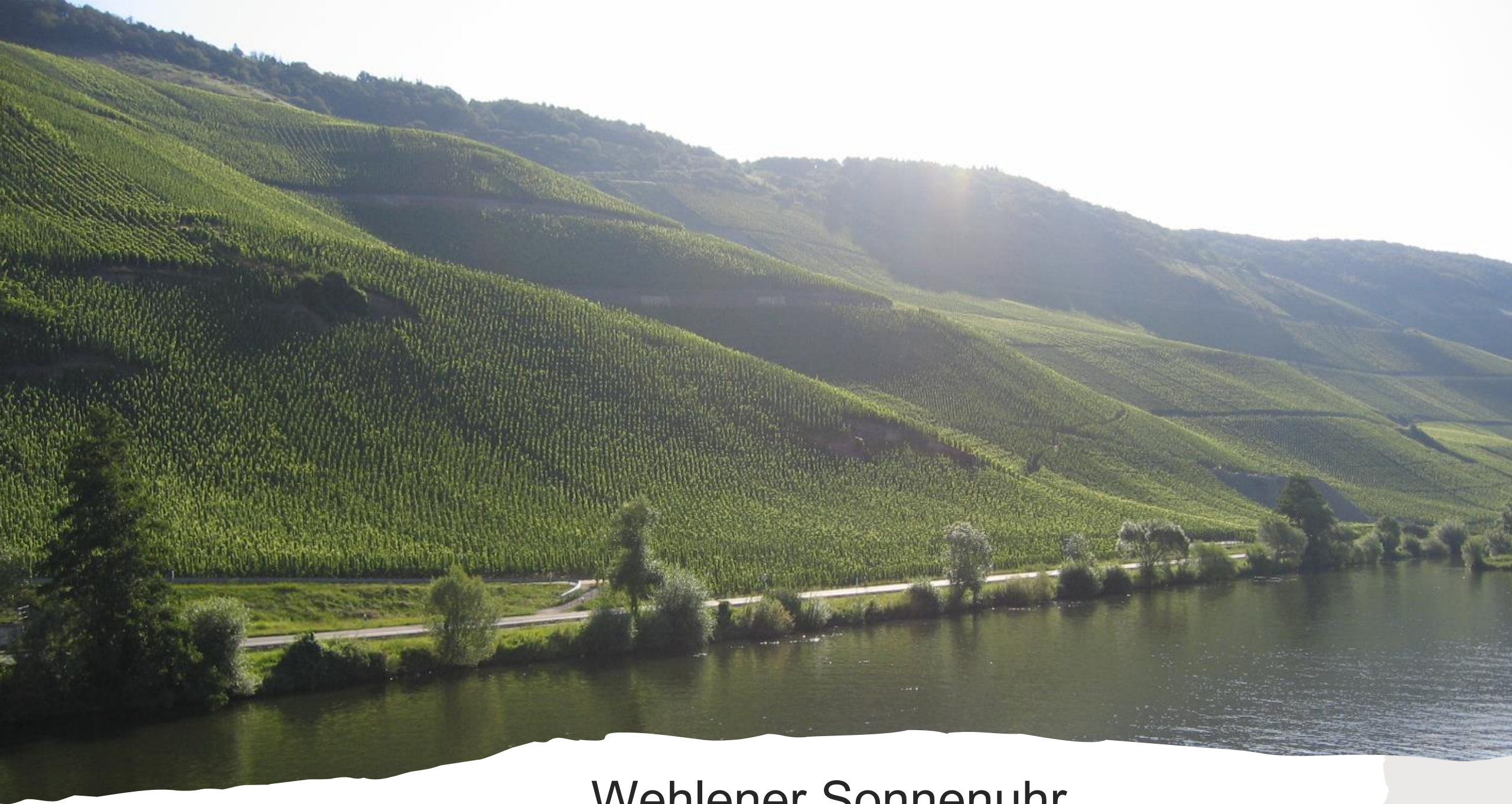


MOSEL

GERMANY'S ICONIC RIESLING REGION



- The most classic wine region for Riesling
- The 3rd largest of Germany's 13 wine regions in terms of production
- 91% white wine | 9% red wine
- Follows the winding path of the Mosel River
- Region also includes the Saar and Ruwer tributaries
- Very cool continental climate
- Much of the soil is composed of slate
- Steep vineyards



Wehlener Sonnenuhr

- Founded in 1911
- All of the wines are currently made by Katharina Prüm
- The estate is made of 4 main vineyard sites
 - Wehlener Sonnenuhr
 - Zeltinger Sonnenuhr
 - Graacher Himmelreich
 - Bernkasteler Badstube
- Everything is farmed by hand with organic practices

Pure Weathered Devonian Slate with stones
Hand-harvested
